For the year ended 31 December, 2009

Your Committee of Management submit the financial accounts of the CFMEU Construction & General Division Tasmanian Divisional Branch (the Union) for the financial year ended 31 December, 2009.

Committee Members

Principal Activities

The principal activities of the Union during the financial year were: implementation of Divisional Executive Decisions, maintenance of Union Rules, Registrations and Affilitations, co-ordinating seminars and courses for Branch Officers to inform them of current relevant developments, representing the Divisions interest on various state and national committees and organisations, and the provision of member support with industrial and related issues.

There were 764 financial members, and 4 salaried employees, plus one paid by honorarium as at 31 December 2009.

Significant Changes in Activities and Financial Position

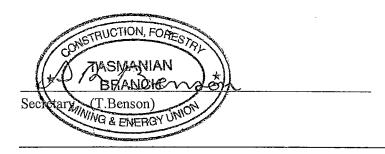
The Tasmanian union branch recorded a decrease in revenues of \$66,637 from the 2008 year. Union membership fees and training fees are expected to decline in the future due to non-union friendly industrial relations laws and changes in training structures in Tasmania respectively. However the government's emphasis on the housing and infrastructure sector's may buffer its impact.

Total costs declined by \$18,857 from 2008 resulting in the branch recording a deficit of \$2,924 in 2009 over a surplus of \$44,855 in 2008.

Rights of Members to Resign

All members of the Union have the right to resign in accordance with Rule 11 of the Union Rules (National) and s174 of the RAO Schedule.

Note 1: Statement of Accounting Policies

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with the Statement of Accounting Concepts and applicable Accounting Standards. The accounts have been prepared on the basis of historical costs and do not take into account changing money values or, except where stated, current valuations of non-current assets. The accounting policies have been consistently applied, unless otherwise stated. The report is a general purpose financial report and has been prepared under the RAO schedule.

In accordance with the requirements of s272 of the RAO schedule, members attention is drawn to the following:

- (1) A member of a reporting unit, or Registrar, may apply to the reporting unit for specified prescribed information in relation to the reporting unit to be made available to the person making the application.
- (2) The application must be made in writing and must specify the period within which, and the manner in which, the information is to be made available. The period must not be less than 14 days after the application is given to the reporting unit.
- (3) A reporting unit must comply with an application made under subsction (1).

Lodgment of Financial Statements and Accounts –
Tasmanian Branch, Construction & General Division - for year ended 31 December 2009 (FR2009/10237)

The financial year of the Tasmanian Branch, Construction & General Division, has recently ended. This is a courtesy letter to remind you of the obligation to prepare the reporting unit's financial documents and to lodge audited financial accounts and statements with Fair Work Australia within the prescribed time frame unless a 1 month extension or an application for a certificate of exemption under the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations)* Act 2009 ('the RO Act') is applied for and granted.

The documents you must lodge include:

(i) A <u>general purpose financial report</u> [see section 253(2)]; (ii) A <u>Committee of Management statement</u> (see the General Manager's Reporting Guidelines); (iii) An <u>operating report</u> [see section 254(2)]; (iv) An <u>auditor's report</u> [see sections 257(5) to 257(11)]; and (v) A <u>certificate</u> of the <u>secretary or other designated officer</u> [see section 268(c)].

I draw your particular attention to

- (a) s237 which requires you to prepare and lodge <u>a separate statement</u> providing the prescribed particulars of any loan, grant or donation made during the year which exceeds \$1,000;
- (b) s265(5) which requires you to publish or otherwise *provide your members with completed/signed copies* of the audited accounts, report and statements before final presentation and lodgment; and
- (c) s266 which requires you to <u>present the completed documents to an eligible meeting</u> (either of the members or of the committee, whichever applies). Note that this meeting is distinct from any initial committee meeting convened to prepare, sign or otherwise approve pre-audited documents.
