Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union-Mining and Energy Division Tasmanian Re: District Branch - Financial Reporting Obligations under Workplace Relations Act 1996

This is a courtesy letter to remind you of the financial reporting obligations of the abovenamed body under the Workplace Relations Act 1996 ('the Act') for the financial year ended 31 December, 2003.

While the accounting, auditing and reporting obligations have changed with the introduction of the Registration and Accountability of Organisations Schedule (the RAO Schedule) which generally came into operation on 12 May 2003, Part IX, Division 11 of the Act continues to apply in relation to a financial year of an organisation that ends on 31 December, 2003. The corresponding obligations set out in the RAO Schedule apply to each financial year of an organisation that starts on or after 1 July 2003.

Now that the financial year for 31 December, 2003 has ended, it is timely that you put in train the various steps of the financial reporting requirements. To assist you with this process I have enclosed for your information a notice summarising these requirements including the time-scales prescribed by the legislation.

Please note that a branch of an organisation may be exempted from the accounting, auditing and reporting obligations in respect of a financial year by satisfying a Registrar that the branch did not have any financial affairs during the financial year. An application under subsection 271A(1) of the Act must be made within 90 days (unless extended by a Registrar) after the end of the financial year.

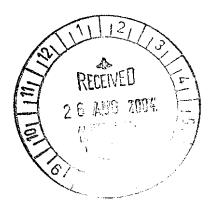

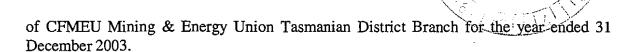
INDEPENDENT AUDIT REPORT

Scope

We have audited the attached "Financial Report", comprising:

- Balance Sheet (Page 1)
- Profit & Loss Statement (Page 2)



We have audited the financial report of CFMEU Mining & Energy Union Tasmanian District Branch for the year ended 31 December 2003 as set out on pages as above. The management of the governing body are responsible for the financial report. We have conducted an independent audit of the financial report in order to express an opinion on it to the members of CFMEU Mining & Energy Union Tasmanian District Branch.

Our audit has been conducted in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards to provide reasonable assurance whether the financial report is free of material misstatement. Our procedure included examination, on a test basis, of evidence supporting the amounts and other disclosures in the financial report, and the evaluation of accounting policies and significant accounting estimates. These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion whether, in all material respects, the financial report is presented fairly in accordance with Accounting Standards and other mandatory professional reporting requirements and Sections 272, 273 and 276(4) of the Workplace Relations Act (1996) so as to present a view which is consistent with our understanding of the CFMEU Mining & Energy Union Tasmanian District Branch financial position, the results of its operations and its cash flows.

Branch Financial Statements for years ending 31 December 2002 (FR2002/828) and 31 December 2003 (FR2003/710)

I acknowledge receipt of these documents which were lodged in the Registry on 26 August 2004.

I refer to our phone conversation today. I drew your attention to the dates on which the committee of management certificates and accounting officer's certificates for both matters had been signed by yourself ands Mr Hinds. Both appeared to have been signed after the date of the respective auditors' reports.

I explained that the Workplace Relations Act specifies the preparation of certain documents within certain time scales. The two certificates are required to be prepared before the auditor makes his or her report.

You indicated that administrative difficulties within the organisation had affected the preparation of documents on this occasion but that you expected that these had now been overcome. I indicated that the organisation's next financial statements would have to be prepared under the requirements of the Registration and Accountability of Organisations ("RAO") Schedule to the Act and that strict time lines would now apply for the preparation, provision to members and lodgement in the Registry of financial documents and reports.

Although different requirements will apply to your next financial return, I draw your attention to the need to carefully observe the requirements of the legislation when preparing your documents and seek your written confirmation of the following matter. In particular:

Financial year ending 31 December 2002

• the committee of management certificate for this year omitted to state a matter required to be addressed, namely whether the organisation complied with s279 of the Act in relation to the financial accounts for the year ended 31 December 2001, and the auditor's report thereon. Section 279 provides that an organisation "(1) shall provide free of charge to its members (a) a copy of the report of the auditor in relation to the inspection and audit of the accounting records kept by the organisation in relation to the financial year; and (b) a copy of the accounts and statements prepared under section 273 to which the report relates". Could you please confirm that these documents were provided to members as required.

A further omission but on which no further action is sought on this occasion relates to the financial year ending 31 December 2003

Information to be provided to members or registrar

The financial documents for this year omitted the statement required to be included under s274(4) of the Act. The statement was included correctly with the financial documents for the year ending 31 December 2002 - see page 8 Note 2.

Upon written confirmation of the organisation's compliance with s279(1), the documents for 31 December 2002 will be filed.

The documents for 31 December 2003 will be filed.
