# Section 271 Certificate of Exemption - Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union, Victorian Branch - for year ending 31 December 2011 (FR2011/2841)

I refer to the applications dated 20 April, 20 June and 17 July 2012 which were lodged with Fair Work Australia on 27 April, 22 June and 19 July 2012 respectively for a certificate of exemption under s271 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* in respect of the Victorian Branch of the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union for the financial year ending 31 December 2011.

Section 271(3) requires an application under subsection 271(1) to be made within 90 days after the end of the financial year, or such longer period as the General Manager allows. Given that its financial year ended on 31 December 2011, the reporting unit was required to lodge its application under subsection 271(1) by 31 March 2012. The initial application was not lodged with FWA until 27 April 2012.

Given that a formal request for an extension of time was included within the applications, and that the reasons for such a request were provided on 22 June and 19 July 2012, I have granted an extension of time under subsection 271(3) of the Act on this occasion.

I expect that procedures will be put into place to ensure that future applications are lodged within the time limits specified in the Act.
