I refer to the application dated 26 March 2013 which was lodged with the Fair Work Commission on 28 March 2013 for a certificate of exemption under s271 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the Act) in respect of the Western Australian Branch (the Branch) of the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union for the financial year ending 31 December 2012.

To be granted a certificate of exemption under section 271 of the Act, an application must include a statement which includes all of the prescribed circumstances as outlined in regulation 165 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009), and in particular, regulation 165(b). The statement must include words to the effect that:

Other reporting units of the organisation (Divisional or District Branches within the state of Western Australia) expend their own economic resources or incur financial obligations so that the Western Australian Branch can conduct its activities.

The current application states that 'no other reporting unit of the organisation expends its own economic resources so that the Branch may conduct its activities'.

Once an amended statement is lodged which confirms the above prescribed circumstances, the Commission will be in a position to be able to issue a certificate.
