Section 271 application for certificate of exemption from the requirements of Part 3 of Chapter 8 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the Act) (FR2014/475)

I refer to the application lodged pursuant to section 271(1) of the Act by the Western Australian Branch of the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union (the reporting unit) for the financial year ended 31 December 2014. The application was lodged with the Fair Work Commission on 1 May 2015.

Subsection 271(3) of the Act requires an application for exemption from financial reporting to be lodged with the Commission within 90 days of the end of each financial year or such longer period as the General Manager allows. For the reporting unit the request for exemption must be lodged by 31 March. As stated above, the request for exemption was not lodged with the Commission until 1 May.

On 6 May 2015 the reporting unit requested an extension to the period to lodge the application for exemption from financial reporting requirements, on the grounds that staffing issues prevented the timely filing of the application.

Having regard to the normal and reasonable expectation that registered organisations take steps to ensure that they comply with the time-frame requirements set out in the Act, I have decided to allow a longer period for lodgement <u>in this instance</u> alone.

It should be noted that failure of the reporting unit in future years to lodge an application for exemption from financial reporting before 31 March, unless exceptional circumstances exist, is likely to result in a refusal to grant the exemption under section 271(1). In this circumstance, financial accounts for the reporting unit will need to be prepared, including the requirement to have those accounts audited and provided to members, as well presented to a meeting of members for ratification, in accordance with section 266 of the Act.

As the application is therefore granted, a certificate to this effect is attached.
