Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 6 July 2012 the New South Wales Branch of the SPSF Group of the CPSU, the Community and Public Sector Union lodged with Fair Work Australia the prescribed information in relation to an election for the following offices:

- Branch President
- Branch Vice-Presidents (3)
- Branch Secretary
- Branch Assistant Secretaries (2)
- Branch Assistant Secretary Sub-Branch No.1
- Delegates to Branch Council (10) (who are Branch members not allocated to Sub-Branch No.1)
- Delegates to Branch Council (3) (who are Branch members allocated to Sub-Branch No.1)

[2] The Branch was informed that the prescribed information was not lodged before the day prescribed by Regulation 138(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009*. That day is the day occurring 2 months before the first day when a person may, under the rules of the organisation or branch, become a candidate in the election. The Branch then asked me to allow a later day for lodgment of the prescribed information under subsection 189(2) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the Act). Having considered the reason for late lodgment, I allow lodgment on 6 July 2012 in this instance.

[3] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

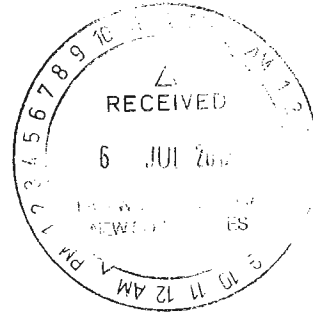

57 – CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS

- E. For all purposes relating to elections conducted under paragraph (i) of Sub-Rule A of these rules, the financial membership of persons eligible to nominate persons to offices within the Group, to accept nomination for election to those offices and to vote in any such election shall be ascertained as follows:
- (i) Those persons who are financial members of the Group as at seven (7) clear days prior to the date upon which nominations for the office or offices the subject of the election or elections are to open shall be eligible to nominate persons for, or, inter alia, be candidates nominated for, such office or offices.
 - (ii) Those persons who are financial members of the Group as at the close of the roll of voters shall be eligible to vote in an election.
 - (iii) A roll of financial members eligible to vote in the election or elections shall be prepared as at seven (7) clear days prior to the date upon which nominations for the office or offices the subject of the election or elections are to open.
