NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE CPSU, THE COMMUNITY & PUBLIC SECTOR UNION (SPSF GROUP) NEW SOUTH WALES BRANCH FUND ACCOUNTS FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2003

1. ACCOUNTING METHODS

In accordance with generally accepted accounting principles for organisations, the accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the accounting standards jointly issued by the Australian professional accounting bodies. In particular:

- (a) The accounts have not been adjusted to record either change in the general purchasing power of the Australian dollar or in the price of specific assets.
- (b) The New South Wales Branch not being an employer, no provision has been made for long service leave, accrued annual leave, etc.
- (c) No provision for income tax is necessary as trade unions are exempt from income tax under Section 50-15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act, 1997.

2. <u>INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO MEMBERS OR</u> REGISTRAR

In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of sub-sections (1), (2) and (3) of Section 274, which read as follows:

- (1) "A member of an organisation, or a Registrar, may apply to the organisation for specified prescribed information in relation to the organisation."
- (2) "An organisation shall, on application made under subsection (1) by a member of the organisation or a Registrar, make the specified information available to the member or Registrar in such manner, and within such time, as is prescribed."
- (3) "A Registrar may only make an application under subsection (1) at the request of a member of the organisation concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a member information received because of an application made at the request of the member."

3. CONTINGENT LIABILITIES

Contingent liabilities are not taken up in the accounts.
