Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 29 July 2010 I made arrangements under subsection 189(3) of the Act for the conduct of an election for a number of offices and positions within the PSU Group of the abovenamed organisation.

[2] On 1 September 2010 I received correspondence from the PSU Group of the organisation requesting an amendment to Schedule D to delete the Section Councillor position for subsection 41.03 - Health Services Australia and to renumber the Section Councillor position for subsection 41.04 - Department of Human Services to 41.03.

[3] On 2 September 2010 I received further correspondence from the PSU Group seeking the inclusion of one (1) Section Secretary for section 39 - National Security Section and one (1) Section Councillor for subsection 18.01 - FaHCSIA Australian Capital Territory brought about by recent vacancies in those positions.

[4] As the conduct of the election for the offices and positions contained in my decision of 29 July 2010 has not yet commenced by the Australian Electoral Commission, my decision of that date is amended in line with the requests made by the PSU Group on 1 and 2 September 2010.

Re: Request for amendment of casual vacancy in conduct of 2010 casual elections for an office and position other than office

The CPSU wishes to notify FWA of an error in the FWA Declaration of 30 July 2010 regarding a vacancy listed for Section Council Sub-Section 41.03 Health Services Australia. That error has occurred because that Sub-Section was incorrectly included in the request to FWA for the conduct of casual elections on 9 July 2010.

Sub-Section 41.03 Health Services Australia was abolished and moved to a new Sub-Section titled: 19.04 MHS. Sub-Section 19.04 has been correctly listed in the Declaration as containing a vacant position.

Please find enclosed a copy of Out of Session 1.11(D) 10 of 2010 regarding the abolition of Sub-Section 41.03 Health Services Australia and creation of 19.04 MHS. A consequence of this change was a re-numbering of Sub-Sections. Sub-Section 41.04 Department of Human Services became 41.03.

Due to this error, the CPSU requests an amendment in the declaration for the conduct of CPSU casual elections to delete the vacancy listed for Sub-Section 41.03 Health Services Australia and include the renumbering of Sub-Section 41.04 to 41.03.
