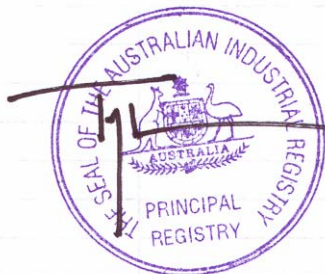
[2] Among the offices mentioned in that decision were:

On 4 June, 2008 I lodge the required information for an election of positions within the Queensland Branch of the State Public Services Federation Group, Community and Public Sector Union.

On 12 June, 2008 I provided the relevant membership figures for the branch for the purposes of Rules 5(ii) and 5 (iii) which were:

Higher Education	2,019
Health	6,385
Other	20,016

Rule 5 (iii) of the branch rules states "Each electorate shall be represented by one (1) Delegate for every 2,000 financial members or part thereof, provided that each electorate shall be represented by at least one (1) Delegate.

The decision (E2008/191) has provided for Higher Education (1), Health (3) and neither Higher Education nor Health (10) on the basis of rounded down Delegate number per 2,000 members and not rounding the number of delegates up for every 2,000 or part thereof, as is required by the Rules.

I would assistance in what steps may be possible to ensure that the numbers of Delegates per electorate are correct as per the Rules and the information provided by me as Branch Secretary in my correspondence of 12 June 2008.
