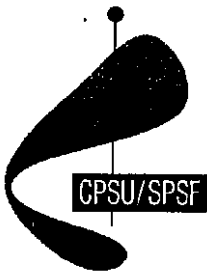

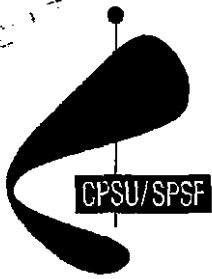

Dear Sir,

Re: Election for Federal Secretary - CPSU, The Community and Public Sector Union - State Public Services Federation Group.

The last election for the Federal Secretary of the SPSF Group of the Community and Public Sector Union was held and declared by the AEC on 4th July 2000.

Rule 55A of the Union's rules requires that:

*"A. The Federal Secretary shall be elected for yearly by secret postal ballot of the whole financial membership of the group...
B. Each election under the rule shall be conducted so that result is declared not earlier than the 1st of June and not later than the 25th of August in an even-numbered year."*

As the term of the current Federal Secretary will therefore expire in July this year, 2004, I write to advise the Registry of this fact and to request that arrangements be made with the Australian Electoral Commission to conduct the required election for the position of Federal Secretary.

I believe that there will be now between one and three months notice available to make arrangements to commence the election, which must be completed at the earliest in one and a half months' time, and at the latest, three and a half months' time.

Please request the AEC to contact me regarding the most convenient timing of the election, the provision of a list of those persons (Federal Councillors) eligible to propose a person who is eligible to be nominated. I can be contacted on Telephone (02) 9299 5655, fax (02) 9299 7181.
