The last election for the Federal Secretary of the SPSF Group of the Community and Public Sector Union was held and declared by the AEC on 12th August 2004.

Rule 55A of the Union's rules requires that:

"A. The Federal Secretary shall be elected for yearly by secret postal ballot of the whole financial membership of the group...
