OFFICE A (FEDERAL SECRETARY)

Reasons for election:

A Federal Secretary election is required due to the expiry of the term of the current incumbent under the rules.

Elected by:

All financial members of the Group (Chapter C Rule 25.1(b)).

The Nominations open:

• On a date determined by the returning officer such that the result is declared not earlier than 1 June and not later that 25 August in the election year (Chapter C rule 19.1(a) (viii)).

Nominations close:

At the date specified by the returning officer in the election notice (Chapter C Rule 17.2)

Cut off date for roll:

A day no earlier than 30 days and no later than 7 days before the date on which nominations for the election open (Chapter C Rule 25.1(c))

OFFICE B (FEDERAL PRESIDENT)

[NB: THE FEDERAL PRESIDENT ELECTION CAN ONLY TAKE PLACE AFTER THE FEDERAL COUNCIL IS ELECTED THROUGH THE BRANCH ELECTIONS WHICH EITHER HAVE OR WILL BE NOTIFIED SEPERATELY]

Elected by:

An electoral college composed of the five Federal Vice Presidents of the CPSU (SPSF). (Chapter C Rule 37.1(b))

The Nominations open:

Nominations must open 14 days prior to the first meeting of the Federal Council at which Federal Vice Presidents are elected. (Chapter C rule 32).

Nominations close:

• On a date at least 14 days and no more than 28 days after the notification of the election of the Vice Presidents (Chapter C Rule 32.5)

Cut off date for roll:

The close of the first meeting of the Federal Council at which the Vice Presidents are elected. (Chapter C Rule 37)
