Re: Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 (RAO Schedule) Financial report for year ended 30 June 2008 – FR2008/250

I have received the financial report for the CPSU, the Community and Public Sector Union of the SPSF Group, Federal Branch for the year ended 30 June 2008. The documents were lodged in the Australian Industrial Registry on 17 December 2008.

The documents have been filed.

Although the documents were of a high standard of which we are most appreciative, there are some minor comments I would like to make to assist you in the preparation of future financial reports.

#### 1. Auditor's Qualifications

The Auditor's Report should provide *details of the individual auditor's qualifications* to confirm he is an approved auditor as defined by s.256 of RAO Schedule and Regulation 4 of the RAO Regulations. Regulation 4 defines an approved auditor as a *person* who is a member of CPA Australia, The Institute of Chartered Accountants in Australia or the National Institute of Accountants *and* holds a current Public Practice Certificate.

While I note it is more than likely that your auditor is an approved auditor as defined by the RAO Regulations the preferred practice is the qualifications of the individual auditor *and* the fact that he holds a current Public Practice Certificate be made explicit in the signature block.

Please forward a copy of this letter to your auditor.

#### 2. Recovery of Wages Activity

I note that the accounts did not provide any information in relation to any recovery of wages activity.

Items 16 – 23, 25(f) and 27(b) of the Industrial Registrar's Reporting Guidelines govern the financial reporting of recovery of wages activity.

In circumstances where the reporting unit has not undertaken any recovery of wages activity for the financial year, a statement by the auditor *or* a declaration in the committee of management statement to the effect that there was no recovery of wages activity for the financial year would be sufficient.

### OPERATING REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2008

In accordance with Sec. 254 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 ("the Act"), your Committee of Management reports as follows:

#### **Principal Activities**

The Principal activity of the Organisation during the year was that of a registered trade union. No significant change occurred in the nature of those activities during the year.

#### **Operating Result**

The operating result of the Organisation for the year ended 30 June 2008 was a Surplus of \$ 2,709 (Surplus \$236,573 year 2007). No provision for tax was necessary as the Organisation is considered exempt.

#### Significant Changes

There was no significant change in the financial affairs of the Organisation during the year.

#### **Rights of Members**

All members of the Organisation have the right to resign from the Organisation in accordance with Chapter C Rule 8 of the Organisation Rules, (and Section 174 of the Workplace Relations Act); namely, by providing written notice addressed and delivered to the Secretary of the Organisation, including via e-mail.

### NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2008

#### **NOTE 1- STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

This report is a general purpose financial report that has been prepared in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards including the disclosure requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996.

The following is a summary of significant accounting policies adopted by the Union in the preparation of the financial report which, unless otherwise stated, have been consistently applied:-

#### (a) Basis of Accounting

The financial report has been prepared on the basis of historical costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where otherwise stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

All income and expenditure of the Union has been brought to account on an accrual basis of accounting so as to match income for the period with the expenditure incurred in earning that income.

#### (b) Employee Benefits

Provision has been made in the financial report for the Union's liability for employee entitlements arising from services rendered by employees to balance date. Employee entitlements expected to be settled within one year together with entitlements arising from wages and salaries, recreation leave and long service leave which will be settled after one year, have been measured at their nominal amount.

Other employee entitlements payable later than one year have been measured at the amounts expected to be paid when the liability is settled, plus related on-cost. In the case of Long Service Leave this results in an amount not materiality different to that achieved by discounting future cash outflows.

#### (c) Income Tax

No provision has been made in the financial report for income tax on the basis that the Union is exempt under Section 50-15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

#### (d) Property, Plant and Equipment

Each class of Plant and Equipment is carried at cost less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation and any impairment in value.

#### Depreciation

The depreciable amount of all fixed assets is depreciated on a diminishing value method over their useful lives to the Union commencing from the time the asset is ready for use.

The depreciation rates used for each class of asset are:

#### NOTE 1- STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONT'D)

#### (d) Property, Plant and Equipment (Cont'd)

The assets' residual values and useful lives are reviewed and adjusted, if appropriate, at each balance sheet date.

Gains and losses on disposals are calculated as the difference between the net disposal proceeds and the asset's carrying amount and are included in the income statement in the year that the item is derecognised.

#### (e) Impairment

The carrying amounts of property, plant and equipment are reviewed for impairment when events or changes in circumstances indicate that the carrying value may not be recoverable. An impairment loss is recognised in the income statement for the amount by which the asset's carrying amount exceeds its recoverable amount. The recoverable amount is the higher of the asset's fair value and value in use. For the purpose of assessing value in use, this represents depreciated current replacement cost, as the Union is a not-for-profit organisation.

#### (f) Comparatives

Where necessary, comparative information has been reclassified to achieve consistency in disclosure with changes in presentation in the current year.

#### NOTE 2- WORKPLACE RELATIONS ACT 1996

In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of sub-sections (1), (2) and (3) of Section 272, which reads:

- (1) A member of a reporting unit, or a Registrar, may apply to the reporting unit for specified prescribed information in relation to the reporting unit to be made available to the person making the application.
- (2) The application must be in writing and must specify the period within which, and the manner in which, the information is to be made available. The period must not be less than 14 days after the application is given to the reporting unit.
- (3) A reporting unit must comply with an application made under subsection (1).
