The relevant information (as at 31 December 2003) is as follows :

- 3. The reasons for these elections are that as follows:
 - (a) In the case of the Branch Officers, CPSU, SPSF Group Rule 54A requires that each Branch shall elect its Branch Officers four yearly. The previous elections for these positions were conducted in 2000.
 - (b) In the case of the Delegates to the Branch Council, CPSU, SPSF Group Rule 54A, together with Victorian Branch Rule 8 requires that the Victorian Branch shall elect its Delegates to the Branch Council four yearly. The previous elections for these positions were conducted in 2000.
 - 4. CPSU, SPSF Group Rule 54A specifies the procedures for conducting these elections. It provides that the returning officer shall fix the date on which nominations close, and that nominations shall be called for at least 14 days prior to the date on which nominations close. The rule further specifies that each election shall be conducted so that the result is declared not earlier than the 1st May and not later than the 30th June in each election year.
 - 5. The voting system to be employed is a direct voting system, and CPSU, SPSF Group Rule 57C provides that the election shall be by secret ballot and shall be conducted by the proportional preferential voting system as set out in the Schedule to the Group Rules.
