

AND

IN THE MATTER OF a request pursuant to Section 214 of the Act for the Registrar to arrange for the conduct of certain elections by the Australian Electoral Commission.

PRESCRIBED INFORMATION IN RESPECT OF ELECTION: REGULATION 61(1)

The following information is lodged in accordance with Regulation 61 of the Act in relation to elections required by the CPSU, SPSF Group, Victorian Branch.

- 1. In accordance with CPSU, SPSF Group Rule 54B elections are required to be conducted for the positions of Victorian Branch Delegates to the Federal Council.
- 2. The reasons for these elections are that the CPSU, SPSF Group Rules require that elections for the Delegates to the Federal Council are to be conducted on the date of the first meeting of the Branch Council after each election of delegates to the Branch Council. Elections for the delegates to the Victorian Branch Council are currently in progress (Election E No. 3015 of 2000).
- 3. The number of Branch Delegates to the Federal Council to be elected is five (5) as specified in CPSU, SPSF Group Rule 25.
- 4. The electorate comprises the members of the Victorian Branch Council.
- 5. CPSU, SPSF Group Rule 54B provides that nominations shall be called for at least 14 days prior to the first meeting of the Branch Council after each election of delegates to the Branch Council, and that nominations close at 6pm on the first day of that meeting. The rule further specifies that each election shall be conducted so that the result is declared not earlier than the 1st June and not later than the 25th August in each election year.
- 6. The voting system to be employed is a collegiate electoral system.
