REQUEST PURSUANT TO SECTION 189 FOR THE REGISTRAR TO ARRANGE FOR THE CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS BY THE AUSTRALIAN ELECTORAL COMMISSION

PRESCRIBED INFORMATION

The following information is hereby lodged in accordance with Subsection 189 of the RAO Schedule of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 and Regulation 138 of the (Registration and Accountability of Organisations) Regulations 2003 of the RAO Schedule of the Workplace Relations Act 1996.

- (a) An election is required for the following offices:
 - (i) Thirty seven (37) Branch Councillor offices and thirty seven (37) Proxy Branch Councillor offices within the Community and Public Sector Union, SPSF Group, WA Branch.
 - (ii) Six (6) Executive Council Offices
 - (iii) Five (5) Federal Council Offices
 - (iv) One (1) Federal Vice President and one (1) Branch Representative on Federal Executive
- (b) The reason for the elections is that the term of each of the offices is due to expire this year.
- (c) More than one office of the same name:
 - (i) Offices of Branch Councillor and Proxy Branch Councillor

Rule 10 sub-rule 10.1 of the CPSU, the Community and Public Sector Union; Chapter C – SPSF Group Western Australia Branch rules provides for the membership of the Branch to be divided into Electorates consisting of such members as is determined by the Branch Council from time to time.

Sub-rule 10.2 provides that an Electorate may consist of all or some members employed by an employer or a number of employers and the minimum number of members who may constitute an Electorate shall be 250 financial members.

Rule 9 sub-rule 9.1of the CPSU, the Community and Public Sector Union; Chapter C – SPSF Group Western Australia Branch rules provides that each Electorate will be represented on Branch Council by one Branch Councillor and one Proxy Branch Councillor for each

500 financial members or part thereof allocated to the Electorate as at 31 December in the year preceding an election.

The Electorates and entitlements for number of offices of Branch Councillor and Proxy Branch Councillor are attached at Attachment A "CPSU-SPSF Group WA Branch Council Electorates at 31 December 2005".

Rule 10.3 provides that there shall be one or more Electorate(s) consisting of members employed in or by a public hospital, private hospital, nursing home, public dental clinic, area health service, community health service or psychiatric service; or employed in or by any department, or part of a department. Council Electorate "17 Health Services" consists of members employed in the Department of Health, psychiatric services and a number of health services. Council Electorate "X Dental Health Services" consists of members employed in public dental clinics.

Rule 10.4 provides that there shall be one or more Higher Education Electorate(s) consisting of all members employed in or by a University, College of Advanced Education, a Department of Technical and Further Education, a College or Institute of Technical and Further Education. Council Electorates "12 Curtin University and Murdoch University", "13 Edith Cowan University", "15 University of WA" and "16 TAFE Colleges" consist of members employed in or by a University, College of Advanced Education, a Department of Technical and Further Education.

Rule 54A sub-rule D of the CPSU, the Community and Public Sector Union; Chapter C – SPSF Group rules provides that the only persons eligible to accept nominations for election as a Branch Councillor or Proxy Branch Councillor for an electorate shall be financial members in that electorate.

(ii) Six (6) Executive Councillors

Rule 33 sub-rule 33.7 of the CPSU, the Community and Public Sector Union; Chapter C – SPSF Group Western Australian Branch rules provides that the six Executive Councillors shall be elected by secret ballot by the members of Branch Council for a term of two years. The persons eligible to accept nomination shall be members of the Branch Council.

(iii) Five (5) Federal Councillors

Rule 25 sub-rule A of the CPSU, the Community and Public Sector Union; Chapter C – SPSF Group rules provides that there shall be five (5) delegates elected to represent the Western Australian Branch of the SPSF Group on the Federal Council.

Sub-rule A further provides that in each Branch one position of Delegate is to be reserved for members who work in Higher Education, one for members who work in Health and one for members who work in neither Higher Education nor Health. If in any election no

member is nominated from any of the three classes then for the purposes of that election there shall be no reserved positions for that class.

Rule 54B sub-rule A of the CPSU, the Community and Public Sector Union; Chapter C – SPSF Group rules provides that the Federal Councillors shall be elected by secret ballot by the members of Branch Council for a term of two years. The persons eligible to accept nomination shall be members of the Branch Council.

(iv) Offices of Federal Vice President and Branch Representative on Federal Executive

Rule 55B sub-rule A of the CPSU, the Community and Public Sector Union; Chapter C – SPSF Group provides that the Federal Vice President and Branch Representatives on Federal Executive shall be elected by secret ballot by the members of the Federal Council from the Branch for a term of two years. The persons eligible to accept nomination shall be members of the Federal Council from the Branch.

(d) Western Australian Branch of the Community and Public Sector Union SPSF Group

(e) (i) Offices of Branch Councillor and Proxy Branch Councillor

Rule 9 Sub-rule 9.4 of the CPSU, the Community and Public Sector Union; Chapter C – SPSF Group Western Australian Branch rules provides that the election for each office shall be conducted so that the result is declared not earlier than 1st May and not later than 30 June in each even-numbered year.

Rule 33 sub-rule 33.1 provides that every election required by the Branch rules shall be conducted in accordance with Chapter C the Federal Rules. Federal Rule 54A sub-rule F provides that nominations for elections shall be called by such means as will give reasonable notice to those persons eligible to accept nomination at least fourteen (14) days prior to the date on which nominations close.

(ii) Offices of Executive Councillor

Rule 33 sub-rule 33.7 of the CPSU, the Community and Public Sector Union; Chapter C – SPSF Group Western Australian Branch rules provides that election for each office shall be conducted in accordance with Rule 54B of Chapter C of the Federal Rules, with the necessary changes being made.

Rule 54B sub-rule B of the Federal Rules provides that the election for each office shall be conducted so that the result is declared not earlier than the 1 June and not later than the 25 August of each even-numbered year.

Rule 54B sub-rule C of the Federal Rules provides that nominations for election of Executive Councillors shall be called by notification of

all members of Branch Council at least 14 days prior to the first meeting of the Branch Council after each two-yearly election of delegates to Branch Council.

(iii) Offices of Federal Councillor

Rule 54B sub-rule B of the Federal Rules provides that the election for each office shall be conducted so that the result is declared not earlier than the 1 June and not later than the 25 August of each even-numbered year.

Rule 54B sub-rule C of the Federal Rules provides that nominations for election of Executive Councillors shall be called by notification of all members of Branch Council at least 14 days prior to the first meeting of the Branch Council after each two-yearly election of delegates to Branch Council.

(iv) Offices of Federal Vice President and Branch Representative on Federal Executive

Rule 55B sub-rule B of the Federal Rules provides that nominations for election of Federal Vice President and Branch Representative on Federal Executive shall be called by notification of all members of Federal Council from the Branch on a date to be fixed. Rule 55B subrule B provides that nominations shall close at least 14 days from but not more than 28 days after the date of notification.

(f) Rule 33 sub-rule 33.1 of the CPSU, the Community and Public Sector Union; Chapter C – SPSF Group Western Australian Branch rules provides that every election required by those rules shall be conducted in accordance with Chapter C of the Federal Rules.

Federal Rule 57 Conduct of Elections sub-rule E (ii) and (iii) provides that persons who are financial members as at seven (7) clear days prior to the commencement date of the ballot are entitled to vote in the ballot.
