RE: REQUEST FOR ELECTION

I am authorised to lodge the following information, being prescribed information, in relation to an election in the SA/NT Branch, Commonwealth Bank Officers' Section, Finance Sector Union of Australia and am also authorised to sign this statement which is lodged in accordance with sub-section 214(l) of the Workplace Relations Act 1996.

(a) The name of the offices in respect of which an election is required by secret postal ballot of financial members of the Branch, are:-

- Branch Secretary
- Branch President
- Committee Members (11 excluding Branch President and Branch Secretary)

Accordingly in respect of Rule 43.1.3 the Branch Committee of Management passed the following motion at it's meeting on 14th May 2003, regarding the eligibility of nominees for the position of Branch Secretary:-

"Branch secretary be authorized to lodge with the industrial Registrar "prescribed information" for election of Branch Secretary on the basis that nominees for the position must be financial members of the SA/NT Branch. Commonwealth Bank Officers' Section of the Finance Sector Union."

(b) The names of the offices in respect of which an election, is required by a collegiate secret ballot of members of Branch Committee, are:-

- Conference Delegate
- Deputy National Executive Delegate
- Vice President
- Vice President - Women

(c) The reason for the election is that the abovementioned offices will expire on 31st October 2003.

(d) The electorate in respect of (b) will comprise the newly elected Branch Committee.

(e) Nominations of candidates in respect of (b) are to be called at the first meeting of the Branch Committee after the declaration of the Branch elections and close shortly thereafter. The election is conducted during the meeting.

- (f) A collegiate voting system is to be employed in respect of (b).
- (g) A direct (secret postal) ballot of financial members voting system is to be employed in respect of (a).

As at 1st May 2003 the number of financial members of the SA/NT Branch of the Commonwealth Bank Officers' Section Finance Sector Union, was 1125.

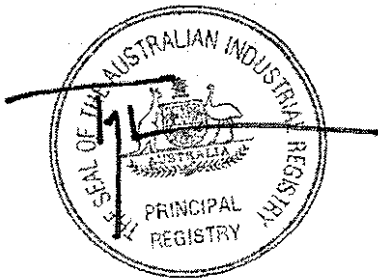
DECISION
