Re: Finance Sector Union of Australia – Election for Office

I am authorised to lodge the following information, being prescribed information, in relation to election for the Assistant Branch Secretary of the Victorian Tasmanian Branch of the Finance Sector Union of Australia.

- a) The name of the Office in respect of which an election is required is “Assistant Branch Secretary”.
- b) The reason for the election is that the term of the office will expire on 21 December 2003.
- c) There is one office in respect of which an election is required.
- d) The electorate comprises the members of the Branch Rule 21.6.1.
- e) Rule 43.3.15 sets out the procedure required by the Rules for the election. As provided by the time table, nominations should be called by 21st September 2003.
- f) The voting system to be employed by the conduct of the election is a direct voting system (Rules 43.3 and 43.6).

I would also like to draw to your attention the provisions of Rule 43.1.3.



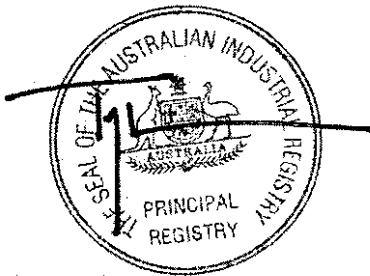
