Section 271 application for exemption from the financial reporting obligations of Part 3 of Chapter 8 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 for financial year ended 30 June 2012 (FR2012/279)

I refer to your application pursuant to s271 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, lodged in the Fair Work Commission on 14 February 2013, in respect of the Flight Attendants' Association of Australia (the FAAA) for the financial year ended 30 June 2012.

I am satisfied that the FAAA is a reporting unit and that it did not have any financial affairs in the financial year which ended 30 June 2012. The attached certificate reflects this decision.

I take this opportunity to remind you of the importance of the reporting unit strictly complying with each applicable aspect of the legislative reporting requirements under the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009* and the Reporting Guidelines.

I have received correspondence from Ms Toni Maystorovich Administrator/Office Manager for the FAAA requesting an extension of time and the reason for this request on the 22 November 2013. In this instance I have allowed the application to be made more than 90 days after the end of the financial year. The FAAA Federal responsibilities including any financial or other requirements have been split equally between the FAAA International and the FAAA Domestic Regional Divisions, this was reported at the end of the financial period 30 June 2008.

The Federal account had ceased to operate and indeed a request for exemption for reporting units was requested and granted for the financial years ending 30 June 2009, 30 June 2010 and 30 June 2011.

Therefore, under this same section s271(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 we are applying for further exemption of any reporting requirements for Federal from the end of year period June 2012.

We are aware that this exemption needs to be applied for each year unless our rules are changed to reflect the need not to report on the Federal.
