Dear Sir / Madam

I writing to clarify the some administrative errors on the application for HSUA election of a Senior National Assistant secretary and National Assistant Secretary received by the Commssion10/02/2004.

Nominations for the two positions have not yet opened, and did not open on the 16th of February 2004 as was the suggested date in the application. The suggested dates were merely an indication of when it was most suitable for the HSUA to hold these elections and were not intended to suggest that nominations had opened or that the HSUA had the authority to determine the opening and closing dates for nominations.

The HSUA will rely on dates for the opening and closing of nominations (and the opening and closing of the ballot) as determined by the AEC Returning Officer under the provisions of rule 19A(c).

The date for closing of nominations is to be determined in accordance with rule 19A(c) rather than 29 (h) (ii) and the roll of voters should close 14 days prior to the opening of the ballot in accordance with rule 19A(f) rather than 7 days prior to the opening of nominations under the provisions of rule 22(g).

I apologise for any confusion caused by the errors contained in the application and assure you that they were unintended.
