If you decide to lodge electronically you have these choices:


- register as a user and then lodge your documents via the AIR eLodgment page of the AIRC website.

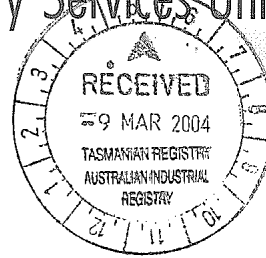



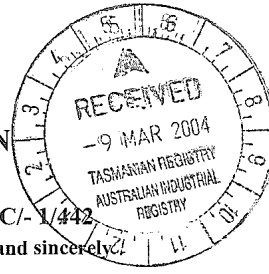

The lodged documents fail to include a record of each election which must be held under the rules of the organisation during the year commencing 1 January 2004 or a statement that no elections are to be held.

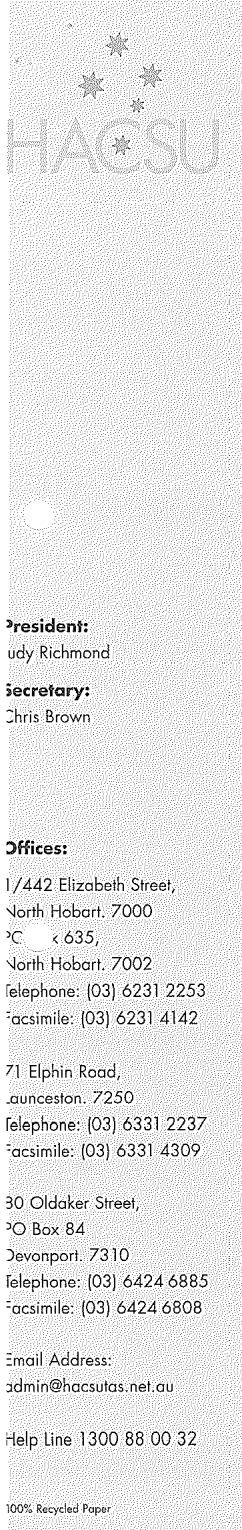

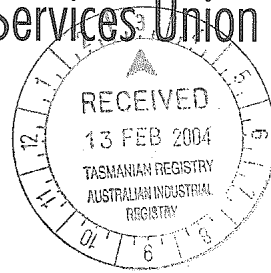


