Re: Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 (RAO Schedule) Financial report for year ended 30 June 2008 – FR2008/235

I acknowledge receipt of the financial report for the Western Australian Branch of the Health Services Union for the year ended 30 June 2008. The documents were lodged in the Industrial Registry on 24 December 2008.

The documents have been filed.

The improvements made to the financial reports have been noted by the Registry. However, there are a few issues arising out of the report and the following comments are to assist you when you next prepare the financial reports. You *do not* need to take any further action in respect of the financial report already lodged.

1. Scope of Auditor's Report

Under the heading "Scope" of the auditor's report, the auditor stated "We have audited the financial report of HEALTH SERVICES UNION WA BRANCH for the year ended 30 June 2008 as set out on the previous pages." The previous pages included a statement of financial performance, a statement of financial position, a statement of cash flows and notes to the financial statements.

Unless the pages were out of order this would suggest the audit did not include an audit of the committee of management statement which appeared subsequent to the auditor's report. Subsection 257(5) of the RAO Schedule requires the auditor to state an opinion on the general purpose financial report and s253(2) defines the general purpose financial report to consist of the financial statements, notes to the financial statements and any other reports or statements required by the Industrial Registrar's reporting guidelines, namely the committee of management statement.

In future please ensure the scope of the audit includes the signed committee of management statement to ensure full compliance with s257(5).

A copy of this letter has been sent to your auditor for his information.

2. Recovery of wages activity

The accounts did not provide information in relation to any recovery of wages activity. The financial reporting obligations regarding the recovery of wages activity is specified in items 16 to 23 and item 25(f) of the Industrial Registrar's reporting guidelines.

Where the reporting unit has not undertaken any recovery of wages activity for the financial year a statement by the auditor or by the committee of management declaring there was no recovery of wages activity for the financial year would satisfy the reporting obligations imposed by the guidelines.

3. References to Schedule 1B in Designated Officer's Certificate

Since 27 March 2006, Schedule 1B of the *Workplace Relations Act 1996* was renumbered to Schedule 1. The top of the Designated Officer's Certificate still contains a reference to Schedule 1B.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2008

Note 1 Statement of Significant Accounting Policies

This financial report is a general purpose financial report that has been prepared in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards, Urgent Issues Group Consensus Views and other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board and the requirements of Sections 253 and 254 of Scendule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996.

The financial report covers HEALTH SERVICES UNION WA BRANCH as an individual entity.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historical costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where stated, current valuations of non-current assets. Cost is based on the fair values of the consideration given in exchange for assets.

The following is a summary of the material accounting policies adopted by the Union in the preparation of the financial report. The accounting policies have been consistently applied, unless otherwise stated.

a. Cash

For the purposes of the Statement of Cash Flows, cash includes cash on hand, at banks and on deposit.

b. Revenue

Revenue from membership contributions is recorded when received.

Interest revenue is recognised on a proportional basis taking into account the interest rates applicable to the financial assets.

c. Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Tax Office. In these circumstances the GST is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of the asset or as part of an item of the expense. Receivables and payables in the Statement of Financial Position are shown inclusive of GST.

Note 6 Information to be Provided to Members or Registrar

In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Realtions Act 1996, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of sections 272(1), 272(2) and 272(3), which reads as follows:

This report is compiled to meet requirements under Section 254 of Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996.

Principle Activities During the Financial Year

The principle activities of the Union during the 2007/2008 Financial Year were as follows:

- representing individual members in grievance disputes with employers resulting in members being treated fairly and their rights respected.
- representing all members at various workplaces regarding disputes with employers resulting in a fair outcome.
- negotiating Enterprise Bargaining Agreements resulting in increased wages and conditions for members covered by those Agreements.
- negotiating Industrial Agreements at a number of worksites resulting in the settlement of disputes or the resulting in flexibility working arrangements.
- providing members with professional indemnity insurance.
- providing Union Delgates and Worksite Committee members with training and education to enable them to better represent members in the workplace.

Significant Changes in the Unions Financial Affairs During the Year

The net assets of the Union increased by \$8,133 during the Financial Year.

Subject to Rule 13 of the rules of the Union and sec 174 of Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 a member has the right to resign from membership by giving written notice addressed and delivered to the Branch Secretary.
