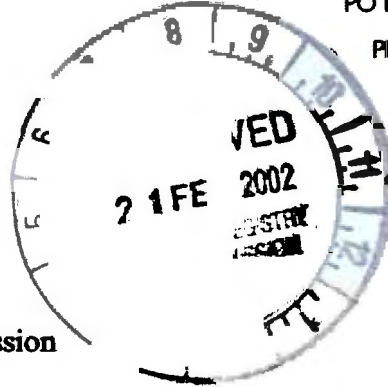

Dear Registrar,

I wish to advise that pursuant to rule 18 of the IEU Constitution, a ballot is required for the election of IEU President, Deputy President, (2) Vice Presidents, Federal Secretary and Assistant Federal Secretary.

For the purposes of subsection 214(1) of the Act and regulation 61, I provide the following information:

- (a) The office of President, Deputy President, two Vice Presidents, Federal Secretary and Assistant Federal Secretary are the offices in respect of which an election is required.
- (b) The election is required because the respective terms of office expire in 2002.
- (c) The rules provide that in the year in which the elections are to be held the close of nominations be fixed between 1st March and 31st March.
- (d) The electorate comprises the Federal Council. The rules provide the officers as listed in (a) be elected by and from Federal Council.
- (e) The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election is the collegiate electoral system.
