
I have attached the Declaration of Results from the Returning Officer for the recent election.

For the purposes of subsection 189(1) of Schedule 1B of the Act and regulation 138, I provide the following information:

- (a) The office of Vice President (Top End Rural) and 1 Ordinary Member are the offices in respect of which an election is required.
- (b) The election is required because the respective terms of office expire in 2004.

- (c) In accord with Branch Rule 7(b), the method of election of the Vice President (Top End Rural) shall be by and from financial members resident in the area of the Top End and for the Ordinary member, be and from the whole membership.
- (d) The Branch Executive has requested that the election be held in time for the process to be finalised as close as possible to November 1, the date by which the new Executive takes office.
- (e) The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election is the direct voting system.
