Re: IEUA - Queensland Branch Elections

In accordance with Section 189(1) of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 and Regulation 138, I provide the following information.

Re 138(1)(a) and (c)

That in accordance with Rule 8 of the Federal Rules of the Independent Education Union of Australia (IEUA) an election is required for:

Federal Council Delegates (7) Seven.

I have advised that the Queensland Branch membership at 31 December 2003 was 11,752 financial members and at 28 April 2004 11,693 financial members.

That in accordance with Rule 6.3(a) of the IEUA Queensland Branch Rules an election is required for:

Branch Executive (32) Thirty-two members.

Re 138(1)(b)

These elections are made necessary in that the current term of office of the incumbents expires as follows:

(ii)	Branch Executive Members	Noon 31 October 2004

Re 138(1)(d)

The electorate for both elections comprises the financial members of the Queensland Branch as determined by Federal Rule 17(q).

Re 138(1)(e)

It is a requirement under Federal Rule 17(h) that the elections conclude no later than 31 October 2004.

In setting dates for the election process I would advise that the Union's journal will be published on 10 June 2004. (Closing date for copy 31 May 2004.)

I would propose the following dates:

Poll Opens	23 August 2004
Poll Closes	14 September 2004 (Noon)

Re 138(1)(g)

The voting system to be used is the direct voting system and is first past the post. The Rules allow for an order of preference to be indicated by the voter (Branch Rule 9.27).

I would further advise that in accordance with the Queensland Branch Rule 10.1, subsequent to the election of the Branch Executive, a Branch Committee of Management is to be elected. The current term of office expires on (Noon) 31 October 2004 (Ballot declared 11 October 2001) (Queensland Branch Rule 9.29. Previous Branch Rule was current in 2001 – Rule 9.3 of the then Rules).

1. The Branch Committee of Management to be elected consists of eight (8) persons:

- One (1) President
- One (1) Assistant Secretary/Treasurer
- One (1) Assistant Secretary

- One (1) Senior Vice-President
- One (1) Junior Vice-President
- One (1) Secretary
- Two (2) Committee Members

These persons are elected by and from the Branch Executive members using a collegiate electoral system.

2. Further, in accordance with Federal Rules 9(a) and 12(f) an Alternate Delegate to the Federal Executive shall be elected by and from the Branch Executive.

I would recommend that a timetable for this second tier not be established immediately as it may be appropriate to consider a timetable in light of whether a ballot becomes necessary for the Branch Executive.
