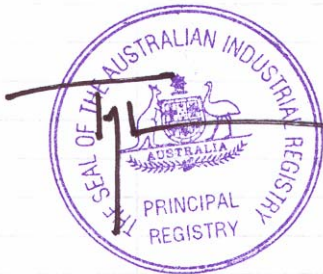
*Arrangement for conduct of election.*

In accordance with Clause 189 (1) of Schedule IB of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 (the Registration and Accountability of Organisations Schedule) and Regulation 138, I provide the following information.

**Reg 138 (1)(a) and (c)**

That in accordance with Rule 8 of the Federal Rules of the Independent Education Union of Australia (IEUA) an election is required for:

Federal Council Delegate (1) One.

I have advised that the Queensland Branch membership at 31 December 2005 was 13,580 financial members.

That in accordance with Rule 8 (c) of the Federal Rules of the Independent Education Union of Australia (IEUA) the IEUA Queensland Branch is, therefore, entitled to eight (8) delegates to Federal Council. Seven (7) delegates have previously been elected.

**Reg 138 (1)(b)**

This election is made necessary in that the current term of office of the incumbents expires on 01 December 2007 and in accordance with Rule 8 (d) of the Federal Rules of the IEUA the additional delegate shall hold office until the same date as other delegates of the Branch.

**Reg 138 (1)(d)**

The electorate comprises the financial members of the Queensland Branch as determined by Federal Rule 17(q).

**Reg 138 (1)(e) and (f)**

It is a requirement under Federal Rule 8 (d) that the election shall be held within six months of the entitlement arising.

In setting dates for the election process I would advise that the Union's journal will be published on 8 March 2006. (Closing date for copy 27 February 2006.)


