In accordance with Chapter 7 Part 2 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, I provide the following prescribed information in accordance with the requirements of subsection 189(1).

Re Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009 – subsection 138(1)(a)

That in accordance with Rule 8 of the Federal Rules of the IEUA an election is required for:

Federal Council Delegate (1) One.

Re Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009 – subsection 138(1)(b)(iii)

I would advise that the IEUA Queensland and Northern Territory Branch (IEUA-QNT) membership at 31 December 2009 was 15,200 financial members.

That in accordance with Rule 8 (c) of the Federal Rules of the IEUA the IEUA-QNT Branch is, therefore, entitled to eight (9) delegates to Federal Council. Eight (8) delegates have previously been elected.

This election is made necessary in that the current term of office of the incumbents expires on 01 December 2010 and in accordance with Rule 8 (d) of the Federal Rules of the IEUA the additional delegate shall hold office until the same date as other delegates of the Branch.

That in accordance with Rule 13.2 of the IEUA-QNT Branch Rules, the electorate comprises the financial members of the Queensland Division.
