Thank you for the financial reports of the Queensland Branch of the Independent Education Union of Australia for the year ended 31 December 2006. The documents were lodged in the Industrial Registry on 28 March 2007. On 8 June 2007 I received further correspondence from you correcting certain passages of the minutes accompanying the above financial reports.

The documents have been filed. No further action is requested in relation to the lodged financial reports for year ended 31 December 2006.

NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2006

1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

This general purpose financial report has been prepared in accordance with Accounting Standards, other mandatory professional reporting requirements and The Workplace Relations Act 1996.

The accounts are prepared in accordance with the historical cost convention. The accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of the previous year.

(a) Income Tax

The association is exempt from income tax under section 50 –15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997. The ongoing applicability of this ruling is at the discretion of the Australian Taxation Office.

(b) Depreciation

Depreciation is calculated on a straight line basis so as to write off the full net cost of each depreciable non-current asset over its expected useful life.

(c) Cash

For the purpose of the statement of cash flows, cash includes deposits at call which are readily convertible to cash on hand and are used in the cash management function on a day to day basis, net of outstanding bank overdrafts.

(d) Goods and Services Tax

Business expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST except where the amount of GST accrued is not recoverable from the Australian Taxation Office.

(e) Impact of Adoption of Australian Equivalents to International Financial Reporting Standards.

This is the first financial report prepared under AIFRS and AASB 1 First-Time Adoption of Australian Equivalents to International Financial Reporting Standards has been applied in preparing these statements.

There have been no adjustments required to assets, liabilities or accumulated funds as a result of the introduction of AIFRS.

NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2006

2. INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO MEMBERS OR REGISTRAR

In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act, 1996, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of Sub-Sections (1), (2) and (3) of Section 272 of the RAO schedule, which read as follows:
