- (a) An election is required in respect of:

- (b) The reason for the election being held is that the term of office has expired.
- (c) There is an entitlement (under Federal Rule 8c) to three (3) Delegates to Federal Council, there being 3575 financial members in this Branch.
- (d) The electorate comprises only members of the IEU(SA) Branch.
