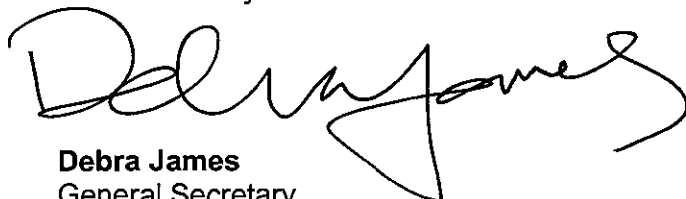
The following documentation is attached:

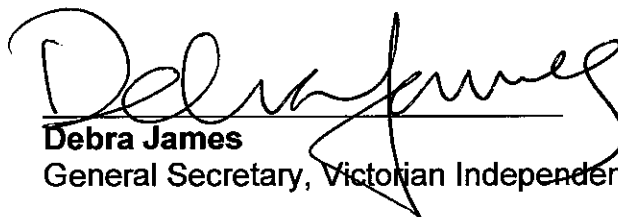
STATEMENT
