Reasons for Election:

Elected by:

- The electorate is the whole of the Branch, using the direct voting system.

Nominations Open:

- At a date to be determined by the Branch Executive in accordance with rule 17(h) of the IEUA federal rules.

Note: A Member shall be eligible for election as a Member of the Branch Executive if:

- *The member is financial at the date of closing of nominations; and*
- *The member has been a financial member for a period of twelve months (in accordance with 6.7 of the IEUA WA Branch rules)*

Nominations Close:

- 21 days after the publication of the first advertisement (in accordance with rule 17(h) of the IEUA federal rules)

Cut-off Date for Roll:

- 7 days prior to the opening date for nominations (in accordance with rule 17(q) of the IEUA federal rules)
