Statement and Notice of Prescribed Information under Regulations 138

Offices/Positions

President – elected by a direct voting system

Metro Vice President – elected by a direct voting system

Country Vice President - elected by a direct voting system

Treasurer – elected by a direct voting system

Vice President General (if applicable) – elected by a direct voting system

Executive Members – (20 positions, 10 from Councils designated as Metropolitan members and 10 from Councils designated as Country members) elected by direct voting system

Reasons for election:

Election for offices and positions is required as the terms of office are due to expire in the normal course of events under the rules of the organisation.

Election for the position of Vice President General will only be required if the incumbent President runs for election and is re-elected. If the incumbent President runs for re-election and is defeated then he will atomically fill the position of Immediate Past President and the position of Vice President General becomes superfluous and will not be filled.

Elected by:

The positions of PRESIDENT, Vice Presidents, Treasurer and Vice President General (if applicable) are elected by the nominated voting delegates of member councils. All voting delegates are permitted to vote for these positions.

The positions of EXECUTIVE MEMBER are elected by the nominated voting delegates of member councils at large. That is, for example, all voting delegates are permitted to vote for both the Metropolitan Executives and the Country Executives.

Nominations open:

For the positions of President, Vice Presidents, Treasurer and Executive Member nominations open at least 7 weeks prior to the first day of the annual conference, ie on or about 3 September 2010. The first day of the annual conference is Monday 25 October 2010.

Nominations close:

For the positions of President, Vice Presidents, Treasurer and Executive Member nominations close at least 4 weeks prior to the first day of the annual conference, on or about 24 September 2010.

Roll of Voters

In accordance with the Association's Rules, the Roll of Voters is to be closed seven (7) days prior to the date upon which the Returning Officer calls for nominations for an election.

Associations' Rule Regarding Elections

The Rules outlining the process by which the President, Executive members and Office Bearers are elected are set out in Schedule C.
