- (9) a record of the number of any members who were ineligible State members within the meaning of s150 (only if the organisation has entered into a s151(1) agreement).
- (10) a *declaration* signed by you or other prescribed officer that the preceding copies of information being lodged are correct statements of the information contained in the organisation's records

I am writing to remind you again of your obligations under section 233 of Schedule 1 of the *Workplace Relations Act 1996* (the RAO Schedule). 

You should note that failure to comply with this obligation is subject to a civil penalty provision under section 305 of the RAO Schedule.




