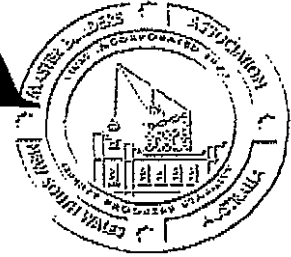

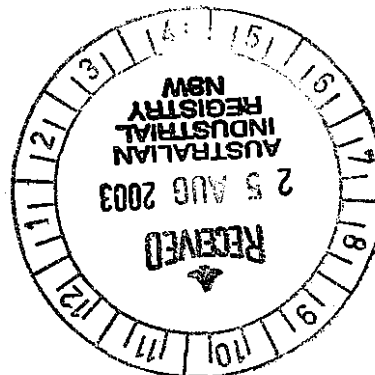

SUB-SECTION 214(1) OF THE
WORKPLACE RELATIONS ACT 1996**

I am the Public Officer of the Master Builders Association of New South Wales and am authorised to sign this statement which is lodged in accordance with sub-section 214(1) of the Act.

1. The offices in respect of which elections are required are for two representatives of each of the Regional and Sector Groups of the Organisation.
2. The reasons for which the elections are required are:
 - (a) The Association's rules require elections of Councillors on an annual basis.
3. The electorate for the elections are:
 - (a) In respect of the two Councillors from each Regional Group, the members of that Regional Group; and
 - (b) In respect of the two representatives of each of the Sector Groups the members of those Sector Groups.

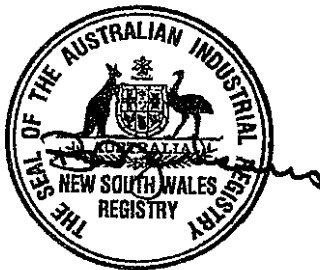
