Declaration and information lodged under subsection 233(1) for 2019 (AR2019/53)

I acknowledge receipt by the Registered Organisations Commission (the ROC) on 21 March 2019 of the organisation's Annual Return which provides information under subsection 233(1) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act).

Thank you for providing the Annual Return. The documents lodged provide the required information for the 2019 Annual Return of the Master Builders Association of the Australian Capital Territory (MBAACT).

The Annual Return has been filed. I should however state that the Annual Return includes 'Chief Executive Officer' in the list of the holders of offices of the MBAACT. I note that Rule 19(d) of the MBAACT's rulebook states that the Executive Director 'shall be the Association's Chief Executive Officer', whilst rule 19(a) states that the Executive Director shall be appointed by the Executive Committee, and rule 19(c) states that the appointment may be terminated by the Executive Committee. Section 143 of the RO Act states that "*The rules of an organisation must provide for the election of the holder of each office in the organisation*". There does not appear to be any provision in the MBAACT rulebook for an election of a Chief Executive Officer (or an Executive Director) being elected to an office, pursuant to the RO Act. Accordingly, it appears the Chief Executive Officer is not the holder of an office, and should not be included as an office holder in the Annual Return. Unless there is another rule which contradicts the above, please ensure the Chief Executive Officer is not included as an office holder in next year's Annual Return. Annual returns are publicly available on the website through the List of Registered Organisations.

Notifications of Change

I also acknowledge receipt of a Notification of Change on 12 August 2019 to the office holders of the Master Builders Association of the Australian Capital Territory.

This information was lodged with the ROC pursuant to the notification requirements in section 233(2) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act).

Time frames

Regulation 151 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009* prescribes that a notification of change pursuant to section 233(2) of the RO Act must be lodged within 35 days of the change occurring.

Officer Induction Kit

The Kit includes a number of resources that will help an officer to understand their general duties as an officer and their specific duties as an officer in your organisation. It also includes tools to guide an officer's understanding of compliance dates and other reporting obligations.

The ROC strongly recommends that all new officers, and officers who are seeking more information on their obligations and duties, are given the link to the officer induction kit. Mandatory disclosures

Please ensure that all new holders of office are advised of their obligations to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests. Details are contained in the RO Act and are summarised in the ROC's <u>Disclosures Fact Sheet</u>.

Mandatory training

Please also note that Section 293K of the RO Act requires each officer with duties that relate to financial management to undertake approved training that covers the duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers are advised of the requirement to undertake approved training. Please also ensure that they undertake the training within the required timeframe. Further information about training is provided in our <u>officer financial</u> training fact sheet.
