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

Regulation 151 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009* prescribes that a notification of change pursuant to section 233(2) of the RO Act must be lodged within 35 days of the change occurring. As foreshadowed in previous correspondence, a review of the Master Builders Association of the Northern Territory trading as Master Builders Northern Territory's compliance with section 233(2) is being conducted by the ROC. Repeated contravention of provisions of the RO Act will be met with an appropriate and proportionate regulatory response from the ROC, which may include inquiries, investigations and civil penalty proceedings.

Officer Induction Kit

Please also note that Section 293K of the RO Act requires each officer with duties that relate to the financial management to undertake approved training that covers the duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers are advised of the requirement to undertake approved training. Please also ensure that they undertake the training within the required timeframe.
