Election for Office - Master Grocers Association of Victoria ("MGAV")

As an Organisation registered under the Workplace Relations Act 1996 (the "Act") we hereby request that arrangements be made for the conduct of elections by the Australian Electoral Commission under s 189 of Schedule 1B (Registration and Accountability of Organisations) of the Act ("RAO Schedule").

We furnish the following presented information under Regulation 138 of the Workplace Relations (Registration and Accountability of Organisations) Regulations:

- a) Elections are required for the offices of directors of the MGAV under clause 21 of its rules and the election of the President and Vice-President under clause 24 of its rules.
- b) The reason for the election is that the office of the directors is due to expire in the normal course of events under clause 21.6 of the rules.
- c) Elections are required for the offices of three (3) directors and the offices of President and Vice- President.
- d) Under clause 21.19 of the rules notice that nominations are required for the election of a director must be sent to each member by the returning officer at least 72 days before the annual general meeting. The annual general meeting ("AGM") of the MGAV must be held no earlier than 31 August 2003 and no later than 30 November 2003 under clause 20.1 of the rules. The returning officer must receive nominations for the offices of directors no later than 5pm 21 days after the electoral officer under clause 21.24 sent nominations forms to members. At this stage the AGM is planned for a date in November depending on arrangements for a timeframe with the AEC.
- e) Under clause 24.2 the directors of the MGAV is obliged to elect a President and Vice-President annually.
- The rules do not provide for a day on which the roll of voters is to be closed. Under the rules ballot papers are posted to members (clauses 25.5 and 25.8) and the closing date for the ballot shall be determined by the electoral officer which shall not be later than noon on the second day before the AGM.
- g) A direct voting system is used in the conduct of an election for directors.
- A collegiate electoral system is used for the conduct of the election for President and Vice- President.

We attach a statement under s 189(2) of the RAO Schedule that the above information is lodged under s 189(1) of the said Schedule. Do not hesitate to contact the undersigned should you require any further information.
