#### Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Commission a declaration of results for the election [E2015/139]. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and persons elected to office.

Section 154D(1) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act) requires the rules of organisations (and branches of organisations) to require each officer with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers undertake approved training within the required timeframe.

Please also ensure that all new holders of office are advised of their obligations to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests, the details of which should be provided for in your organisation's rules.

Also, section 233(2) of the RO Act requires that an organisation must notify the Fair Work Commission (the Commission) within 35 days of any changes to the holders of office in the organisation. If the election has resulted in any changes to the holders of office, the Master Plumbers & Mechanical Contractors Association of New South Wales, The must notify the Commission of these changes. In particular, please advise:

- 1. Person(s) who have ceased to hold office:
  - the name of the office vacated;
  - the date of the change of office holder; and
  - the name of the person vacating the office.
- 2. Person(s) who have commenced to hold office:
  - the name of the office now held;
  - the date of the change of office holder;
  - the name of the person now holding the office;
  - the postal address of the person (generally the postal address of the organisation); and
  - the occupation of the person now holding the office.

The notification must include a declaration by the Secretary (or other prescribed officer) that the information is a correct statement of the changes made. I have attached a template notification of changes which may assist you. If any change does not apply until a specific date, you don't need to notify until then (e.g. AGM, 1 January, 2nd Monday in March). If you have already lodged this information, please disregard this reminder.

I refer to the above election for your organisation. #### Master Plumbers and Mechanical Contractors Association of NSW E2014/256

I refer to correspondence of 7 December 2014 from the Fair Work Commission (FWC) regarding the conduct of an election under Section 189 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009.

The Australian Electoral Commission declared the results for uncontested Officers and Executive Committee members on 27 February 2015. A copy of the declaration of the result of Election E2014/256 was included in the Association's Annual Return lodged on 31 March 2015.

As a result of that declaration there remains two(2) vacant positions on the Executive Committee of the Association.

At the first Executive Committee meeting of the newly elected Officers and Executive Committee members, the General Manager provided a verbal report on discussions held with the Australian Electoral Commission regarding the filling of the two vacancies.

Rule 29 of the Association's Rules deals with the filling of Casual Vacancy in the Executive Committee.

Advice previously obtained from the Fair Work Commission indicated that the Executive Committee could not fill such vacancies on its own motion, but should apply to the FWC for an election to fill the vacancy.

The Executive Committee carried the following resolution:

"The Executive Committee requests the General Manager to write to the Fair Work Commission to seek approval for the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) to conduct an election to fill the two (2) vacant positions on the Executive Committee resulting from the declaration of the pole in relation to E2014/256 by the Returning Officer for the AEC on 27 February 2015".

Accordingly, I now make that application on behalf of the Executive Committee as per their resolution to conduct an election for the vacant positions on the Executive Committee.
