



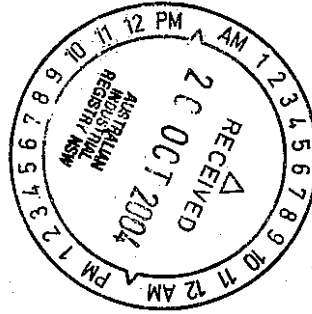

I refer to our conversation today concerning our request for an election in the Media, Entertainment & Arts Alliance.

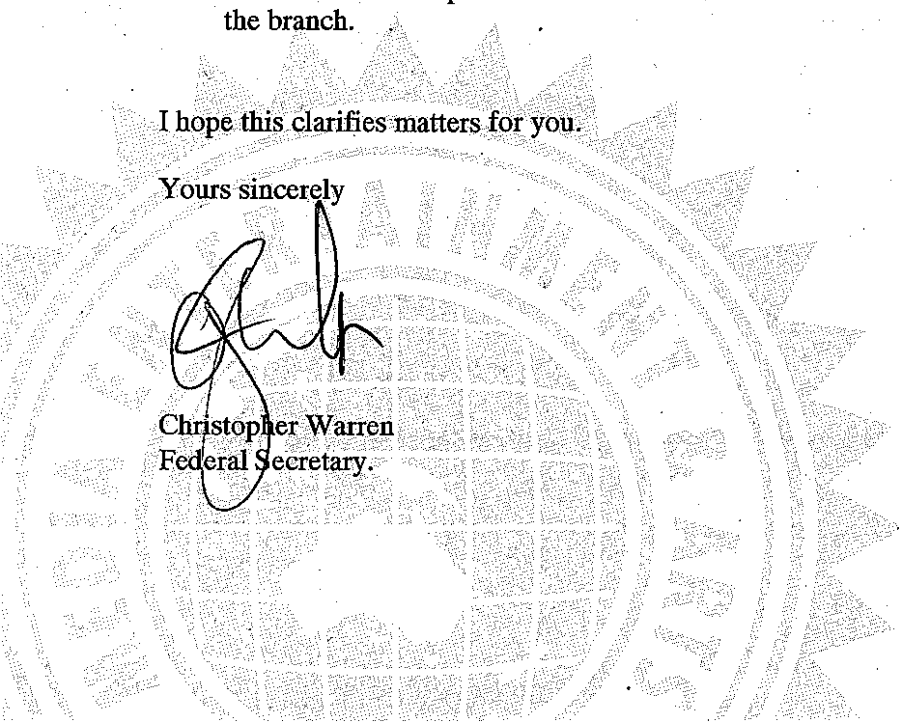
As discussed, I can advise as follows:

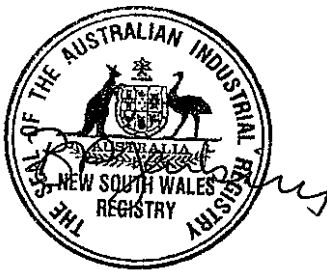

CORRECTING DECISION

On 18 October 2004 I made arrangements under section 189(3) of Schedule 1B of the *Workplace Relations Act 1996* for the conduct of elections for various offices in the abovenamed organisation.

It has come to my attention that the Decision contained two errors. Firstly, for the offices of Sectional Delegates from the AJA section to the Branch Council of the South Australia Branch the number three was given as the minimum number of women required, whereas under the formula set out in sub-rule 79(c)(3) the number should have been four; and secondly, for the offices of Branch Vice-Presidents of the Professional Sports Branch, a minimum of one woman was stipulated, whereas in accordance with sub-rule 79(c)(3) the formula set out in that sub-rule does not apply to the Professional Sports Branch, and no gender requirements should have been included.

Accordingly, my Decision of 18 October 2004 is corrected by firstly, in the case of the minimum women Sectional Delegates from the AJA Section to the Branch Council of the South Australia Branch, altering the number three to four; and secondly, in the case of the Branch Vice-Presidents of the Professional Sports Branch, deleting the stipulation for one woman.
