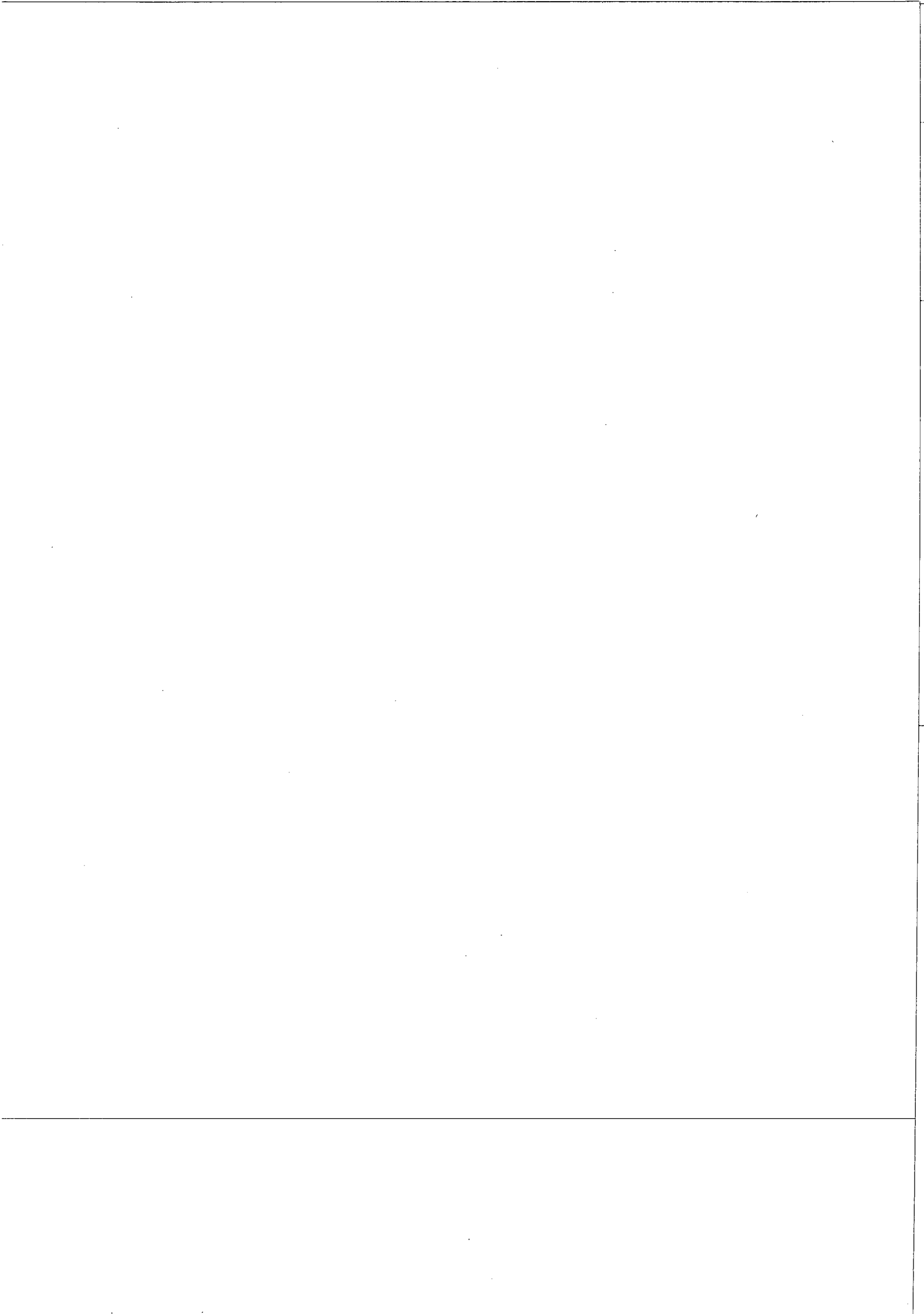
Section 198 and the regulations also require an organisation to make the post election report and the organisation's response to the report (if applicable) available to members.






