If a website is not available, publishing a notice in a journal or newsletter would be considered appropriate.

DECLARATION

Pursuant to the Workplace Relations Act, s189, I, Christopher John Warren, hereby provide the following information:

- 1. THAT I am the Federal Secretary of the Media, Entertainment & Arts Alliance an organisation of employees registered under the Workplace Relations Act 1996;
- 2. THAT an election was conducted for positions in the Alliance with nominations closing on May 11, 2007.
- THAT at the closure of nominations, insufficient nominations had been received for the position of Queensland Branch President, Equity Section delegates to Queensland Branch Council and positions on the Stunt Grading Panel.
- 4. THAT accordingly, a new election is required under Rule 79 for the following positions in the Media, Entertainment & Arts Alliance:

QUEENSLAND BRANCH PRESIDENT (One Position)

QUEENSLAND BRANCH COUNCIL EQUITY SECTION DELEGATES (Four Positions, at least one must be a woman)

NATIONAL STUNTS COMMITTEE

[Equity section members graded as stunt co-ordinators and safety supervisors]

Three positions, of which, two must be stunt co-ordinators [one of which must be a woman], and one must be a safety supervisor.

- 5. THAT all these positions are honorary positions.
- 6. THAT all positions are for a two year term expiring at the next biennial Alliance elections in 2009.
- 7. THAT the electorate for the Queensland Branch President comprises all members of the Queensland Branch of the Media, Entertainment & Arts Alliance.
- 8. THAT the electorate for the Equity Sections delegates to Queenland Branch Council comprises of all equity section members of the Queensland Branch.
- 9. THAT the electorate for members of the National Stunts Committee comprises all Equity section members graded as stunt co-ordinators and safety supervisors.
- 10. THAT in accordance with Rule 69(a), the Federal Management Committee resolved at its meeting on 6 August 2007, that nominations for vacant positions be called in the Alliance Annual Report and close on Monday 12 November 2007. Should a ballot be necessary, close Friday 21 December 2007. The Rules of the Media, Entertainment & Arts Alliance do not prescribe the period for which nominations must be called.

- 11. THAT the voting system to be employed in the elections is a direct voting system.
- 12. THAT as Federal Secretary of the Media, Entertainment & Arts Alliance I am duly authorised to sign this Statement.
