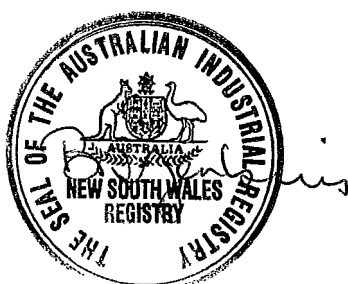

4. Professional Sports Branch

In 1993, the Alliance set up the Professional Sports Branch as a separate structure to organize professional sports members. Our most enduring success in that area has been with the incorporation of the Australian Basketball Players Association.

However, the Branch and related sectional structure has been less successful.

Accordingly, we propose to abolish the Branch and Section structure and roll the members back into the ATAEA section and to the relevant geographical branch. The ABPA will continue to operate as a committee with its own by-laws which are not in contradiction with the Alliance rules.

This involves the following rule changes:

THAT Rule 79 (c) (3) be amended by deleting the following: “(other than those applying to the Professional Sports Section or Professional Sports Branch)”.

It is not necessary for this rule change to be made before the change to the Branch and Section is made.

Recommendation: THAT the Professional Sports Branch and Section be abolished and the relevant categories of membership be allocated to the ATAEA Section and the relevant geographical branch.

5. Award modernization

The Federal Government is implementing a program of award modernization which is supposed to lay the groundwork for the collective bargaining regime to be implemented from 2010.

This is fundamentally different from earlier rounds of modernization or simplification which were about stripping conditions.

These new awards are also expected to act as common rule awards across industries.

Assistant Federal Secretary Mark Ryan (who represents the Alliance on the ACTU industrial legislation and award modernization committees) has prepared the attached report on the actions to be taken by the Alliance.
