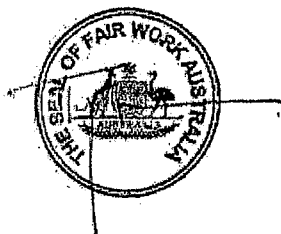

1. THAT I am the Federal Secretary of the Media, Entertainment & Arts Alliance an organisation of employees registered under the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009;
2. THAT an election is required under Rule 79 for the following positions in the Media, Entertainment & Arts Alliance:

2 Stunt co-ordinators [one of whom must be a woman]


3 Safety Supervisors [one of whom must be a woman]

All positions are honorary positions.

All positions are for the balance of the two year term.

3. THAT the electorate comprises all members of the Media, Entertainment & Arts Alliance, Stunt Performers.
4. THAT in accordance with Rule 79, the Federal Management Committee resolved at its meeting on 21 February 2011, that nominations open on 11 April 2011 and close on 27 April 2011. Should a ballot be necessary, it should open on 16 May 2011 and close on 6 June 2011. The Rules of the Media, Entertainment & Arts Alliance do not prescribe the period for which nominations must be called.
5. THAT the voting system to be employed in the elections is a direct voting system.
6. THAT as Federal Secretary of the Media, Entertainment & Arts Alliance I am duly authorised to sign this Statement.
