I refer to the prescribed information dated 4 November 2014 which was lodged with the Fair Work Commission (the Commission) on the same date for the conduct of a scheduled election for offices of the Media, Entertainment and Arts Alliance.

Before a Decision can be made the following matters need to be rectified:

1. Section 189(2) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the RO Act) states that prescribed information must be lodged before the prescribed day, which under regulation 138(3) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009 is two months before the first day when a person may become a candidate. You have indicated that nominations open on 15 December 2014. Accordingly the prescribed day is 2 months prior to 15 December 2014, which on this occasion is 15 October 2014.

Since s.189(2) of the RO Act is a civil penalty provision and the prescribed information for this election was not lodged before the prescribed day, the Delegate of the General Manager will require a written request for an extension of time and providing reasons why the prescribed information was not lodged before the prescribed day.

2. The prescribed information states that it is lodged under subsection 230(1)(d) of the RO Act. That reference is incorrect. Prescribed information should be lodged under subsection 189(1) of the RO Act.

Could you provide amended prescribed information addressing the abovementioned issues. Once the amended prescribed information is lodged the Commission will be in a position to issue a decision to the Australian Electoral Commission.
