
#### 7.2 General Division

**46**. THE Board shall have power at any time and from time to time to elect any eligible person to fill a casual vacancy on the Board where the remaining term does not exceed 12 months or three quarters of the term of the office (whichever is greater). Any person so elected by the Board shall hold office only until the next following Annual General Meeting but shall then be eligible for re-election.

However, if it is intended that any eligible person fill a casual vacancy on the Board where the remaining term exceeds 12 months or three quarters of the term of the office (whichever is greater) a ballot must be conducted and the provisions of Rules 42 and 43 shall, with due alteration of detail, apply to the election of the member to fill such vacancy.

If, at the conclusion of this meeting there are no suitable nominees put forward then the Chair of the meeting will put forward for approval a resolution that we direct ROC to initiate the Upper North Casual Board Representative election process via the Australian Electoral Commission.
