# Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Fair Work Commission (the Commission) a declaration of results for the election E2016/81. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and persons elected to office.

Section 233(2) of the RO Act requires that an organisation must notify the Commission within 35 days of any changes to the holders of office in the organisation. If there are no changes a notification is not required. If the election has resulted in any changes to the holders of office, The Motor Trade Association of South Australia Incorporated must notify the Commission of these changes.

In particular, please advise:

Person(s) who have ceased to hold office:

- the name of the office vacated:
- the date of the change of office holder; and
- the name of the person vacating the office.

The notification must include a declaration by the Secretary (or other prescribed officer) that the information is a correct statement of the changes made. I have attached a template notification of changes which may assist you. If any change does not apply until a specific date, you don't need to notify until then (e.g. AGM, 1 January, 2nd Monday in March). If you have already lodged this information, please disregard this reminder.
