## **RE: Election of Office Holders for the Motor Traders' Association of New South Wales**

I am writing to you to request that you arrange for the election of Office Holders of the Association. I supply the following information with regard to the election as required by RAO regulation 138.

The positions are Division Councillors, Division Alternate Councillors and Executive Board members.

The Associations Constitution sets out the election process for the positions as follows:

- Councillors and Alternate Councillors are elected from the members of each Division as set out by Rule 39.
- Executive Board members are elected from the Councillors elect as set out by Rule 40.

Please note the following change which has taken place since the last election a new Division called the Rental Vehicle Division has been formed by the Governing Council as per Rule 11(6). Under Rule 11(6) the Council at a meeting held on the March 2004 approved the formation of the Division, a copy of the Minutes of that meeting is attached.

Mr McCall said that the **MTA Financial & Insurance Brokerage** was continuing to write good levels of business and this will ultimately reflect well on the MTA balance sheet.

**Apprenticeship Plus** has continued to build on its numbers. There was a late start on getting the program on its way. He said that the ground work had been done and that the number of apprentices engaged will continue to grow next year to ultimately provide a valuable service for the industry and members.

Mr McCall referred to the Training Department's performance on the 2003 results stating that they were good and offered congratulations to Ms Danielle Andrews for her competent management of the Training Department.

The Authorised Inspections Scheme negotiations has been ongoing, Mr McCall referred to a commitment by the Minister prior to the election that he would review the AIS scheme payments after the election, but with a preliminary small increase prior to the election. He stated that the RTA had come back with a \$5 suggestion and that \$3 would go back to the repairer based upon electronic computer transfer utilisation and \$2 would go towards the RTA to cover management of the scheme. The meeting expressed concerns regarding requirements to use computers and software as a condition of payment and that this requirement would isolate some members.

**Mr E Lee** took this opportunity to present a Chairman's meeting motion that was seconded by **Mr R Talbott** "that MTA take up with the Minister the issue of an appropriate AIS Scheme fee equal to \$35 + GST"

#### **Motion Carried**

The CEO went on to report that the License Used Car Division had met with The Hon. Joe Hockey regarding GST and the Minister offered a critical review of this issue and the Division will report back in due course.

Mr McCall reported that the Franchise Dealer Project was continuing. An MTA survey received too small a response to allow the project to continue to this point and a consultant has been engaged to expand the list of responses to assist in further pushing our issues in relation in the franchising code.

Mr J McCall said that generally the Association was working well.

#### **7. RENTAL VEHICLE DIVISION FORMATION:**

Mr McCall stated that Rental Vehicle businesses were keen to utilise MTA Services and be part of the MTA. He said to facilitate this it was necessary to resolve to provide for a Rental Vehicle Division.

**IT WAS AGREED THAT** the Governing Council agree to reinstate the Rental Vehicle Division. This motion was carried.

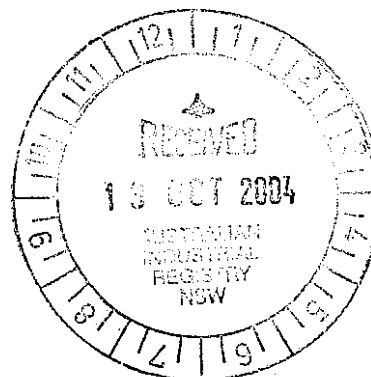
