# Rules

Rules used for the election: [066N: Incorporates alterations of 22 December 2014 in matter number D2014/64]

#### Rules difficult to apply/interpret:

- 1. Rule 38 (5) and 39 (6) state that the candidate has the right to withdraw his candidature at any time before the returning officer finalises the ballot paper where a ballot for the respective position is required or before the declaration of the election if a ballot is not required. This rule is difficult to apply because:
  - If there are no more nominations than positions and a ballot is not required, then it is unclear when or whether candidates can withdraw their nomination:
  - the date of finalisation of the ballot paper is not known when the notice of nominations is sent and therefore candidates do not have certainty about the timeline for withdrawal

This rule is difficult to apply as late notice of withdrawal may prevent the Returning Officer from opening the ballot on time. It is recommended that the Association specify a period for withdrawal, for example, 7 days after close of nominations.

# Other Matters

Returning Officer actions required (Section 193): Yes Details:

The matters in which I have exercised the authority given to me by s.193 of the Act are:

1.Rule 38 (5) and 39 (6) state that the candidate has the right to withdraw his candidature at any time before the returning officer finalises the ballot paper where a ballot for the respective position is required or before the declaration of the election if a ballot is not required. This rule is difficult to apply because:

- If there are no more nominations than positions and a ballot is not required, then it is unclear when or whether candidates can withdraw their nomination;
- the date of finalisation of the ballot paper is not known when the notice of nominations is sent and therefore candidates do not have certainty about the timeline for withdrawal

The Returning Officer applied subparagraph 193(1) (b)(ii) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisation) Act 2009 to fix a closing time for the withdrawal of the nomination. The withdrawal period was fixed within two weeks from the date of the close of the nomination period.

**2**.Rule 38 16 (d) states that "each candidate will be requested to, but is not required to, lodge within seven days, of the notice of ballot, a written statement signed by him not exceeding 200 words in length setting out such information in relation to his candidature as he may consider relevant."

This rule is difficult to apply because it relies on a "notice of ballot" which is not provided for elsewhere in the rule. The Returning Officer applied subparagraph 193(1) (b)(ii) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisation) Act 2009 to fix a closing time for the submission of the candidate statement and the prospective candidates were advised to submit the statements within one week from the date of the close of the nomination period.

- **3**.Rule 39.12 states that candidates be notified of defective nominations by telegram. This communication method is not in practice. The Returning Officer applied subparagraph 193(1) (b)(ii) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisation) Act 2009 to remedy this and notifications of the defective nominations were decided to be sent by email.
- **4**.Rules regarding the timetable of the election were set aside as the AEC held concerns that the coronavirus pandemic may impact on the ability for stakeholders to fully participate in the election. A timetable for the conduct of the ballot which varied from the rules was set when the AEC was satisfied that stakeholders would be able to fully participate.
- **5**.Rules specifying the method of lodgement of nominations were set aside as the AEC held concerns that the coronavirus pandemic would impact on the ability for potential candidates to nominate. Instead, nominations were received electronically, via email/the AEC's portal.
- **6**.Rule 39(8) of the Organisation states that the notice of the election inviting the nomination is to be delivered by hand or post. The Covid-19 issue has affected the capacity of Australia post to deliver letters in time. It also has restricted the delivery of the notice by hand due to health concern. To fix this issue, the Returning Officer applied Section 193(1) (b) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisation) Act 2009 and sent the election notice by email to relevant electorate.

# **DECISION**

Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 s.189—Arrangement for conduct of an election

#### **Motor Traders' Association of New South Wales**

(E2020/215)

MR STEENSON

SYDNEY, 22 DECEMBER 2020

Arrangement for conduct of election.

- [1] On 3 December 2020 the Motor Traders' Association of New South Wales (the organisation) lodged with the Registered Organisations Commission (the Commission) prescribed information for an election to fill the offices set out in **Attachment A**.
- [2] I note that the numbers to be elected to offices of the Governing Council (specifically, Councillors and Alternative Councillors) have not been included in the prescribed information. This is due to sub rule 29(2)(a) of the organisation's rules (the rules) which is replicated below:

Each Trade or District Division of the Association, the membership of which is one hundred or less at the nomination opening time of an election of Councillors shall elect one Councillor (and one alternate Councillor), each Trade or District Division which has membership exceeding one hundred but not exceeding five hundred at nomination opening time shall elect two Councillors (and one alternate Councillor for each Councillor), in each Trade or District Division which has membership exceeding five hundred but not exceeding eight hundred at nomination opening time shall elect three Councillors (and one alternate Councillor for each Councillor), in each Trade or District Division which has membership exceeding eight hundred but not exceeding one thousand at nomination opening time shall elect six Councillors (and one alternate Councillor for each Councillor), in each Trade or District Division which has membership exceeding one thousand but not exceeding one thousand five hundred at nomination opening time shall elect seven Councillors (and one alternate Councillor for each Councillor), in each Trade or District Division which has membership exceeding one thousand five hundred but not exceeding two thousand at nomination opening time shall elect eight Councillors (and one alternate Councillor for each Councillor), in each Trade or District Division which has membership exceeding two thousand at nomination opening time shall elect nine Councillors (and one alternate Councillor for each Councillor).

[emphasis added].

- [3] Sub rule 29(2)(a) operates such that numbers of particular office holders to be elected (namely Councillors and Alternative Councillors) must be ascertained on the same date as the opening of nominations. It is my understanding that it is the usual practice of the organisation to provide those numbers directly to the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC).
- [4] Sub rule 29(2)(a) is unusual in that in most elections for office in registered organisations, the number of offices to be elected would be clear at the time prescribed information is lodged. However, the operation of sub rule 29(2)(a) is such that it creates

difficulties for both the Commission and the AEC. For the Commission, it means that the Commissioner or his Delegate is unable to identify, at this stage or at any time prior to the opening of nominations, the specific number of Councillors and Alternate Councillors required to be elected from each Division. It also leaves the AEC in the position where, based on the rules of the organisation, the number of offices to be listed on the notice calling for nominations cannot be finalised before the day that it is required to go out.

- [5] This omission is concerning and, in my view, exposes a deficiency of the rules. It is my strong recommendation, therefore, that the organisation seek to remedy its rules to enable the identification of numbers of all offices in a timely manner *before* the opening of nominations. This will in turn ensure any future election decisions (or later amendments thereto) accurately identify the number of all offices to be elected under the rules.
- [6] As part of the lodgement of prescribed information, the organisation informed the Commission that it had already lodged proposed rule alterations with the Fair Work Commission (FWC) and that the rule changes apparently did not affect the forthcoming 2021 election. On 16 December 2020, at the request of the Commission, the organisation provided a copy of the rule alterations lodged with the FWC.
- [7] It is apparent on the face of the proposed rule alterations that they deal with a range of amendments some being minor 'stylistic' changes; others involving changes to election rules identified in the AEC post-election report for the previous election (E2018/235) as requiring attention. I note that while these amendments neither create nor abolish offices, nor change the timing of the opening of nominations, they do in fact have the potential to affect the conduct of the election.
- [8] Section 189(3) requires that if the Commissioner (or his Delegate) is satisfied that an election is required to be held under the rules of the organisation or branch, he must arrange for the conduct of the election by the AEC.
- [9] Notwithstanding that I am unable to determine the precise number of officers to be elected from each Division (for the reasons outlined above), I am nevertheless satisfied that an election for offices outlined in **Attachment A** is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act* 2009, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.
- [10] In the event that the proposed rule alterations are certified by the FWC before the opening of nominations and affect the conduct of this election in any way, it is open to the Commissioner or his Delegate to issue an amending decision.

- 1. I am the President of the **Motor Traders' Association of New South Wales**. I am authorised to sign this statement containing prescribed information concerning the forthcoming elections of the Motor traders' Association of New South Wales.
- 2. I confirm that the following information is being lodged under subsection 189(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the RO Act).
