The reason for the election is that according to the Rules of the organisation (Rule 73 C(a)) the current office holder's term of office will expire in December 2002.

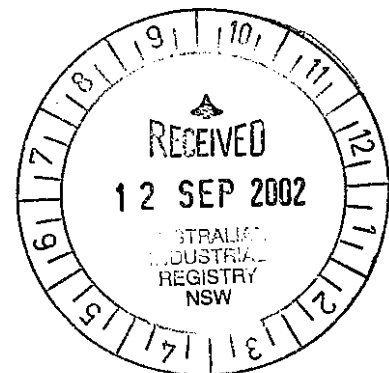
The voting system to be employed in the conducting of the election will be by direct voting system.

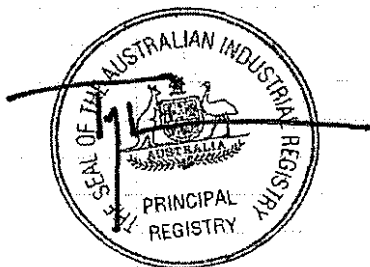



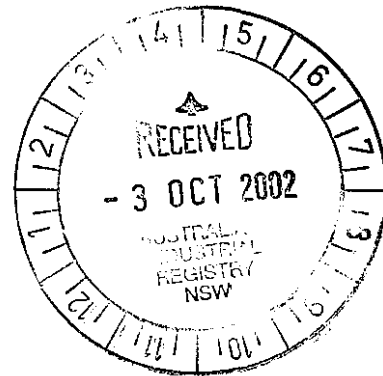
