NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2002

1. Accounting Methods

In accordance with generally accepted accounting principles for organisations, membership contributions are accounted for on a cash receipts basis. Otherwise, the accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Australian Accounting Standards. In particular:

- (b) The accounts have not been adjusted to record wither changes in the general purchasing power of the dollar or in the prices of specific assets.
- (b) Depreciation of fixed assets is calculated on the reducing balance basis in order to write the assets off over their useful life. The committee has made some adjustments to particular items, by way of estimate, to reflect actual wear, tear and obsolescence.
- (c) Provisions for employee benefits in the form of Long Service Leave and Accrued Annual Leave have been made for the estimated accrued entitlements of all employees on the basis of their terms of employment.
- (d) No provision for income tax is necessary as Trade Unions are exempt from income tax under section 23(f) of the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1936*.

2. Information to be provided to members or Registrar

In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of subsections 274(1), (2) and (3), which read as follows:

- (a) A member of an organisation or the Registrar at a member's request, may apply to the organisation for the information prescribed in the regulation
- (b) The industrial organisation must give the applicant the information requested in the application in the time and the way prescribed under a regulation; and
- (c) If the Registrar applies for a member, the Registrar must give the member all information given to the registrar.

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT TO THE MEMBERS

SCOPE

I have inspected and audited the accounting records kept by the MUSICIANS UNION OF AUSTRALIA (BRISBANE BRANCH) in respect of the financial year ended the 30th June 2002, and have received all the information and explanation required for the purposes of the audit.

The organisation's committee of management are responsible for the preparation and presentation of the financial statements and the information they contain. These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion as to whether in all material respects, the financial statements are presented fairly in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards and other mandatory professional reporting requirements and statutory requirements so as to present a view of the association which is consistent with my understanding of the organisation's financial position and the results of its operations and cash flows.
